8. The room has an optional password feature. Just click the checked circular icon and enter your password in the blank field. Adding a password will allow only the players you want to enter the room. Once you are done with the room setting, click on "Create My Room".

#### You still can rename you room in here. The name is important, player only can find your room by your room name, so please remember to rename it.



For example, I want to add a easy question, then click on the easy section.

9. Adding questions to the game is necessary, because the game cannot start without a question. Based on your own subject, enter the question into three different levels of difficulty (Easy/Medium/Hard). Each difficulty level must contain at least one question.
